

HOW INDUSTRY PREPARES FOR HURRICANE SEASON



During a plant's initial construction, buildings are made using reinforced concrete and steel framing to withstand hurricane force winds. Dikes and levees manage potential flooding to protect critical equipment.

Prior to hurricane season, plants get ready by prepping generators, readying on-site crews, stocking supplies, checking satellite phones, and tying down loose equipment.



During a hurricane, highly trained emergency crews are on site closely monitoring the facility to ensure everyone's safety. They work tirelessly to prevent incidents and work with local authorities.



After a hurricane, recovery crews will assess the site for any damage or hazards before employees are brought back onsite and facility operations are restored. Post-hurricane reports are shared with all emergency officials.
